## Connect to the Internet

It's simple. When you turn your phone on for the first time (with the SIM card inserted), it should connect automatically to your mobile operator's data service.

Note If presented with a list of mobile operators, make sure to select the correct one for your SIM card. Contact your mobile operator for more details.

If you want to connect to the Internet using Wi-Fi, you can:

 Press from the Home screen, and then tap Settings > Wireless & networks.

2. Select the Wi-Fi check box to turn Wi-Fi on.

 Tap Wi-Fi settings. Then choose a Wi-Fi network to connect to.

If you select an open network, you'll be automatically connected. If you select a secured network, enter the key, and then tap **Connect**.

## Fast browsing

Browse online catalogues or watch videos from your favorite sites. With support for Adobe® Flash® and HTML5, you can view content-rich sites and not miss a piece of information. From the Home screen, tap ()) > Internet.



## Capture big moments

Use your phone's 5-megapixel camera to take photos in any condition or situation. Whether taking an action shot in the field, a portrait of a friend, or a photo of that romantic dinner, take crisp, clear pictures every time. From the Home screen, tap () > Camera or Camcorder.

#### Portraits

Taking a group picture? HTC Rhyme recognizes faces and adjusts the focus to capture those smiles clearly.

Skin texture in portrait shots appears smoother. On the viewfinder, tap Scenes > Portrait.

#### Action shots

Is your subject a moving target? Your phone can keep up. Use the camera to take continuous shots.

On the viewfinder, tap Scenes > Action burst.

## Email

If you signed into your Google Account when you first set up your phone, you'll be able to send and receive Gmail messages. From the Home screen, just tap **()** > Gmail.

Use the Mail app to set up and manage your other email accounts such as POP3, IMAP, or Exchange ActiveSync.

1. From the Home screen, tap 🏢 > Mail.

2. On the Choose a mail provider screen, tap Other (POP3/IMAP).

If you don't see this screen, press MENU, and then tap More > New account > Other (POP3/IMAP).

3. Enter the Email address and Password for your email account.

4. Follow the onscreen instructions to finish setting up your email account.

In the Mail app, you can check your email messages just in one place without having to switch to different accounts. Just choose the All accounts inbox. Email messages are color coded so you can easily distinguish which email accounts they belong to.




## Before you turn on your phone

Get everything in order before you press the POWER button


#### Removing the back cover

1. Securely hold your phone with the front facing down. 2. With your thumbs, push the back cover out to unlock it.



### Inserting your SIM card

With the cover removed, insert the SIM card (with its gold contacts facing down and cut-off corner facing out) all the way into the SIM card slot.



#### Where's the storage card?


There's already a microSD card in your phone, which is on the right side.



- Push the microSD card in to eject and remove it.
- To reinsert, push it in until it clicks into place.

#### Replacing the back cover

- 1. Align the teeth underneath the back cover with the notches on the side of the phone.
- 2. Press down on the back cover with your thumbs, and then push it until it locks into place.



## Charging the battery

Flip open the small cap on the left side of the phone to access the Micro USB connector. Use the supplied power adapter and USB cable to charge your phone.


