About Nokia Transport

Find the best way to get around using public transport.

You can:

- Get scheduled directions door-to-door, combining different modes of public transport
- Choose earlier or later journeys
- Use Nokia Maps to help you find your way in the walking sections of your journey
- If you have Nokia Maps installed in your phone, you can use Maps to help you find your way in the walking sections of your journey
- Pin your favourite route from your current position as a live tile to the start screen

Public transport routing is available for selected regions around the world. More regions are constantly being added.

Find your way using public transport

Scheduling your journey using trams, trains, and buses can be hard - why not let your phone do the planning?

- 1 Select → > Nokia Transport.
- 2 If you don't want to start your journey from where you are right now, write your start point in the From: box, then select from the matches.
- 3 Write your destination in the **To**: box, then select from the matches.
- 4 To see later or earlier journeys, drag the screen left or right. It may take a few seconds to recalculate the journeys.
- 5 To see a journey in detail, select the journey.

Tip: In the journey details view, to see the next or previous journey, swipe left or right.

Tip: Need help when walking to the bus stop? To see the stop in Nokia Maps, in the journey details view, select the walking section of your journey.

Tip: You can pin your most-used route from your current position as a live tile to the start screen. Select $\bullet \bullet \bullet > \mathscr{P}$.
