

## **Locating the Service Tag**

1	One Touch Dial button	Calls up the stored Fax number.		
2	(Copy) button	Moves to the top menu for the Copy menu.		
3	(Fax) button	Moves to the top menu for the Fax menu.		
4	Data LED	Lights up for incoming, outgoing, or pending Fax jobs.		
5	Ready / Error LED	<ul><li>Lights up when the printer is ready. (Ready LED)</li><li>Lights up when the prinetr has an error. (Error LED)</li></ul>		
6	> <button< td=""><td colspan="3">Moves a cursor or highlight to the selected position.</td></button<>	Moves a cursor or highlight to the selected position.		
7	<b>∧ ∨</b> button	Moves a cursor or highlight to the selected position.		
8	✓ (Set) button	Confirms the entry of values.		
9	(Contacts) button	Moves to the Address Book menu for the Fax and Scan services.		
10	(Redial / Pause) button	Redials a telephone number.		
11	X (Cancel) button	Cancels the current processing or pending job.		
12	B&W / Color LED	Lights up to display which color mode is being selected.		
13		Switches the color mode.		
14	(Start) button	Starts a job.		
15	(Speed Dial) button	Calls up the stored telephone number.		
16	(Backspace) buton	Deletes characters and numbers.		
17	Numeric keypad	Enters characters and numbers.		
18	AC (All Clear) button	Resets the current setting, and returns to the top menu.		
19	(Back) button	Returns to a previous screen.		
20	LCD Panel	Displays various settings, instructions, and error messages.		
21	(Scan) button	Moves to the top menu for the Scan menu.		
22	(Menu) button	Moves to the top menu for the Print from USB Memory, Job Status, and System menus.		

## **Loading Letterhead**

Load the letterhead in the printer with the print-side facing up. Ensure that the title on the letter head enters the printer first.




## **Loading Envelopes**


Load envelopes in the printer as shown below:




To prevent DL and Monarch from being wrinkled, they are recommended to be loaded with the print-side facing up, flap opened, and facing you.





# **Identifying the Location of Paper Jams**

The paper jams may occur at any of the locations shown below:

## **Printing the System Settings Page**

- 1 In the operator panel, press the (Menu) button.
- 2 Press the ✓ button until System is highlighted, and then press the ✓ button.
- 3 Press the ✓ button until Report/List is highlighted, and then press the ✓ button.
- 4 Ensure that System Settings is highlighted, and then press the ✓ button. The system settings page is printed.
