

In multihandset packs, you will find one or more additional handsets, chargers with power adapter units, additional rechargeable battery packs and battery doors.


#### **IMPORTANT**

Only use the telephone line cord supplied.

This equipment is not designed for making emergency telephone calls when the power fails. Alternative arrangements should be made for access to emergency services.

# Getting started

## Step 1. Connect the base



- Plug the power adapter with smaller pin plug & telephone line cord into the base. Power adapter with bigger pin plug is for charger (for multi-pack only).
- Plug the other end of the power adapter & telephone line cord into the wall jack.


#### TIPS

Do not place your phone in the bathroom or other humid areas. Please refer to the user's guide for more cautions when you choose the location of your phone.

#### IMPORTANT

Only use the power adapter and telephone line cord supplied with the product.

### Step 2. Install and charge the handset battery pack



- Slide out the battery compartment cover. Place the supplied rechargeable battery pack in the battery compartment, with the battery connector plugged in, as shown.
- · Slide the battery compartment cover back.
- Put the handset on the base to charge for at least 24 hours. When the handset is fully charged the will indicate that it is fully charged.

#### IMPORTANT

Use only the rechargeable battery pack provided.

# Step 3. Set the display language

- Press and () to select SETUP HS.
- Press and ( ) to select LANGUAGE.
- Press and () to select the language.
- Press view to save.

# Step 4. Set date and time

- Press vert to select DATE & TIME.
- Press i and edit the year and date.

# TIPS

You can press () to move between the input fields YEAR and DATE.

- Press 🖼 and edit the time in 12hr format. Press 🎡 to toggle AM/PM settings.
- Press visit to save the settings.

## NOTE

If you have subscribed to your network's Caller ID service, the date and time is set automatically for all handsets every time a call is received.

# Step 5. Your phone is now ready for use. Handset LCD Display



# **Display** icons



On when the line is in use. Flashes when there is an incoming call.



On when speakerphone is turned on.



On when answering machine is turned on. Flashes when new answering machine message is received. (This icon is displayed for L40x series only.)



Indicates when new call is received. Off when new call has been viewed.



On when ringer volume is turned off.

On when there is new voice mail not yet listened to. 00

Off when new voice mail has been listened to. NEW



On when a call is muted.

- Full battery power level.
- 2/3 battery power level.
- 1/3 battery power level.

Flashes when low battery level is detected, needs charging.

# **2** Using the phone



#### Make a call

Enter the phone number and press 🖾 or 💷 to dial the phone number.

#### Answer a call

When the phone rings and 🔪 flashes in the display, press 🔊 or press 🔄 to answer the call.

#### End a call

During a call, press  $\angle$  or put the handset on the base cradle.

## Adjust volume

During a call, press 🛞.

## Dial from the redial list

- Press 🍚 and then 💮 to the entry you want to redial.
- Press or to dial the number.

# Dial from the calls list

- Press and then 🔅 to the entry you want to dial.
- Press or to dial the number.

# Add entry to phonebook

- Press 💮 and press 🐨 to select ADD.
- Press and enter the name.
- Press and enter the number.
- Press and () to select a melody.

#### Press is to save settings.

## Dial from the phonebook

- Press et then scroll it to select the entry you want to dial.
- Press or to dial the number.

# Set the ringer tone

- Press 🖼 and 🏵 to select SETUP HS.
- Press view to select RINGER TONE.
- Press and () to select a ringer melody.
- Press is to save.

# Set the ringer volume

- Press and () to select SETUP HS.
- Press view to select RINGER VOLUME.
- Press 🖼 and 🛞 to increase or decrease the volume level.
- Press is to save.

# Change the handset name

- Press and () to select SETUP HS.
- Press and () to select HANDSET NAME.
- Press 🖼 and enter your desired handset name.
- Press is to save.

#### Set the LCD contrast

- Press and () to select SETUP HS.
- Press and () to select LCD CONTRAST.
- Press 🐨 and 🛞 to adjust the contrast level.
- Press view to save

### Set auto talk on/off

- Press and (i) to select SETUP HS.
- Press and (a) to select AUTO TALK.
- Press 🖼 and 🛞 to turn on or off auto talk.
- Press view to save

### Reset all settings

- Press and (a) to select RESET SETTINGS.
- Press and (i) to select ALL SETTINGS.
- Press velocity to select YES. Then all the personalized settings will be reset to default

#### NOTE

Phonebook entries, calls list and redial list will remain unchanged.

# Paging/Find handset

- Press 🐵 on the base. All handsets registered to the base will ring.
- handset, or place the handset on the cradle.

# For L40x series only

## Switch the answering machine on / off

Press  $\stackrel{\textcircled{}}{\boxplus}$  at the base to step between answering machine modes. When the base is switched on the display shows  $\bigcirc$  (or other number) when in Announce Only mode, and -when in Answer Off mode

#### Listen to messages

Press the keys below on the base to perform the respective functions:

Press to stop plaving messages or resume plavback.

- Press once to replay current message from the beginning. Press twice to playback the previous message.
- Press to play the next message.
- Press to delete the current message.
- : Increase the loudspeaker volume by one level (0 to 8).
- Decrease the loudspeaker volume by one level (0 to 8).

#### NOTE

Ringer will be off when the volume is decreased to level 0.

# The 📋 icon is not scrolling when the handset is placed on the base

- Bad battery contact move the handset slightly
- · Dirty contact clean the battery contact with a cloth moistened with alcohol
- Battery is full no need to charge

#### No dial tone

- No base power check the connections. Reset the phone: unplug and plug back in the electrical outlet.
- · Handset batteries are empty charge the battery pack for at least 24 hours.
- Handset may be too far from the base move closer to the base.
- · Wrong telephone line cord use the telephone line cord provided.

### Poor audio quality

 The base is too close to electrical appliances, reinforced concrete walls or metal doorframes - move the base away from any electrical appliances.

#### No ring tone

- · The ring tone is deactivated.
- Increase the volume.

### Caller ID does not work

· Check your subscription with your network operator.

### A phonebook entry cannot be stored

· The phonebook is full. Delete an entry to free memory.

#### No display

- Try recharging or replacing the battery pack.
- · Reset the base. Unplug the unit's electrical power, then plug it back in.
- If LED is not lit up, then try to unplug the unit's electrical power, then plug it back in.

# When the handset lost its link with the base during a call

- · Check the power cord is connected properly into the base.
- · Check the power adapter is connected properly into an electrical outlet.
- Move the handset closer to the base. It may be out of range.
- Reset the base by unplugging the unit's electrical power. Wait for around 15 seconds and plug it back in again. Allow up to one minute for the handset and the base to synchronize.

### Noise interference on your radio or television

Your base or charger may be too close. Move it as far away as possible.
